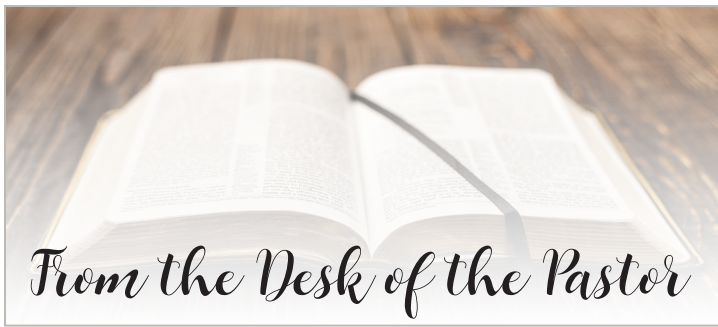

From the Desk of the Pastor

This past week, I traveled to Washington, D.C. for a few days of vacation to visit some friends and brother Dominicans in Northern Virginia and our nation's capital, and then met up with our parish bus group for the March for Life. We were able to attend the National Vigil Mass for Life at the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception on Thursday evening, and then had Mass at the Dominican House of Studies before the March on Friday afternoon (it was great to see Br. Raphael, Br. Patrick, and Fr. Cornelius again!). To conclude the March for Life, Bishop Fernandes celebrated a Mass on Saturday for all pilgrims from the Diocese of Columbus at St. Matthew Cathedral in Washington. It was a prayerful weekend as we witnessed to life and continued to make our voices heard on behalf of the unborn. A special thanks is in order to Lorraine Vance and her son Gabriel, our parish Respect Life Ministry coordinator, for organizing the bus trip.

Here in Columbus, the Bishop will be celebrating a Diocesan Mass for Life on Monday, January 27 at St. Joseph Cathedral at 10:00 a.m., which will be followed by a *Roe Remembrance* at the Statehouse, beginning at Noon. Life is a precious gift from God, and the fact that it isn't protected in the womb in all places is a cry that reaches to the heavens. But we must never lose hope! Jesus is the Lord of Life! If we face setbacks in our fight for life, remember that Jesus fell along the Way of the Cross, but He still got up and persevered to the end, and rose to a new and glorious life. So too for us – though the victory we saw with the overturn of *Roe v. Wade* in 2022 was countered in Ohio with the 2023 abortion referendum, the worst thing we can do now is give up. Our prayers must continue and our witness must be strengthened. This is how God will move hearts to conversion, so that all people will see abortion as a horrific tragedy, and will recognize the dignity of every human life, from conception until natural death.

If we need another reminder of how precious is the gift of life, let us continue to meditate on the Christmas mystery, and how our Savior came to us as a little baby, born in a lowly stable. The birth of Jesus shows us that human life is sacred, because it was created by God, and it is so good that our Lord assumed our human nature in His Incarnation in order to save us. All human life must be protected, because all of us are created in the image and likeness of God, and all of us are brothers and sisters of Jesus in the flesh.

Our Christmas celebrations continue for one more week, and will conclude next weekend with the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord – Candlemas. Our annual Solemn Mass for Candlemas, with the Blessing of Candles, the Procession from Patrick Hall, and the Dominican tradition of the *oblation candelarum*, will take place at the Saturday Vigil Mass, beginning at 5:00 p.m. (please assemble in Patrick Hall before Mass begins). Everyone is encouraged to bring their own candles from home to be blessed, and unblessed candles will be available for purchase before the Vigil Mass. If you can't make it to the Vigil Mass, we will have the Blessing of Candles at all the Sunday Masses as well, though beginning in the rear of the church with the Solemn Entrance.

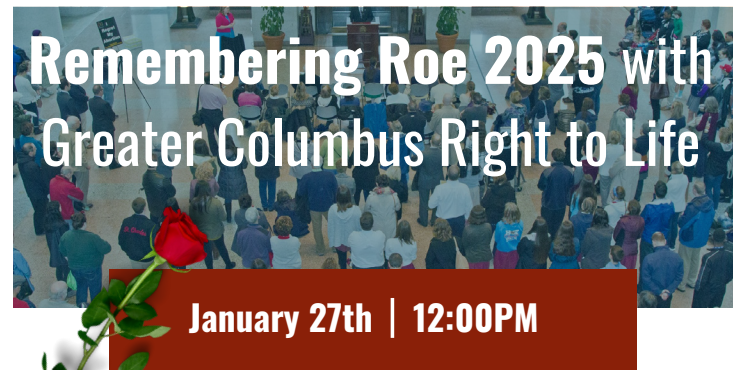

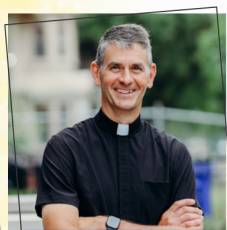
