From the Desk of the Pastor

Today, we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord – Candlemas – which is always a special day for our parish, with our tradition of the Blessing of Candles and Procession, and the *oblatio candelarum*, a Dominican tradition signifying a total offering of our lives to God. It is also the 40th day since Christmas, so today (sadly!) is the final day when we'll see the Christmas lights, decorations, and Nativity scene up in our church and around the parish center.

While we may think of Candlemas as the end of Christmastide, one observance that we cannot forget on this feast is that it is designated every year as the World Day for Consecrated Life. This is because when Jesus was presented in the Temple, Mary and Joseph were fulfilling the Law of Moses, which required every firstborn son to be offered to the Lord. This would have happened for any Jewish boy who was the firstborn in his family. But for Jesus, it shows a particular aspect of His mission – He who became man is now set aside for the Lord, set aside to be offered as a saving sacrifice for His people. In the consecrated life, men and women are set aside, offered to the Lord, to carry out some mission that He entrusts to them. This is why today's feast has a strong connection with those who have dedicated their lives to God through the profession of the evangelical counsels of poverty, chastity, and obedience in religious life or secular institutes, as well as consecrated virgins living in the world, and the vocation of hermits.

At St. Patrick's, you are served by us Dominican Friars. Before any of us were ordained to the diaconate and the priesthood in the sacrament of holy orders, each of us first made our religious profession in the Order of Preachers (initially for a period of three to five years at the conclusion of the novitiate, before making our solemn profession, which is until death). At our parish, you are also graced with the beautiful witness and service of our Dominican Sisters, who have consecrated their lives to the Lord as brides of Christ, as they serve the Church in various apostolates here in Columbus. On this day, please pray for the friars and sisters, that we may fulfill our vocations as consecrated religious, always remembering our total consecration to the Lord, and that we may be diligent in our ministry to you, the parishioners of St. Patrick's.


When you belong to a parish that is administered by a religious community, you start to pick up some of the practices of our way of life in your own spiritual life. This is not by accident! All that we do here at St. Patrick's: our beautiful, reverent liturgies; our faithful, doctrinal preaching and catechetical programs; the community that we forge in our various parish ministries and activities; and the outreach that we do beyond the parish, all flow from the Dominican spirituality which shapes and forms this parish, and the four pillars of Dominican life: community, prayer, study, and preaching. For us friars and the sisters, this is how we approach our vocations, as we live out our consecration to God each day. As parishioners at a Dominican parish, this is how you live out your baptismal promises each day, as you seek to follow the Lord, with the assistance of Our Lady, St. Dominic, and All Dominican Saints (and had the Order existed in the 5th century, I think St. Patrick would have been a Dominican too!).

On a final note – pray for vocations to the consecrated life! Our parish has been blessed over the past few years with a number of parishioners who have joined various religious communities. Pray that the Lord will continue to call people to consecrate their lives to Him from the flock of our wonderful parish.
