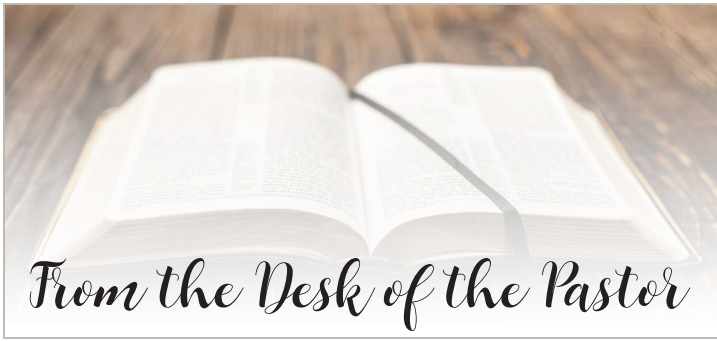

## From the Desk of the Pastor

This upcoming Saturday is the Columbus Catholic Women’s Conference at the Ohio Expo Center, followed by the Columbus Catholic Men’s Conference the following Saturday at the same location. A number of our parishioners have taken part in these conferences in the past, and I know plenty will be going once again this year (and you’ll be seeing some of the friars there to hear confessions). As the conferences approach, I also wanted to use this opportunity to highlight a few of our parish ministries for women and for men.

### FOR WOMEN -

**Women’s Club** – The St. Patrick’s Women’s Club supports the general needs and welfare of the parish and is a long-standing parish organization. The Women’s Club is known for its wonderful bake sales and annual raffle, but it also meets on the second Tuesday of the month at 10:00 a.m. in Aquinas Hall. The Women’s Club welcomes new members and encourages members to attend their monthly meeting. This is a great opportunity for the women of St. Pat’s to serve the needs of the parish.

**Confraternity of Christian Mothers** – This ministry began just a few months ago, and our parish received our own charter for this Confraternity. This ministry, also known as the Mothers Ministry, provides an opportunity for prayer, study, and fellowship for busy moms. The Confraternity of Christian Mothers meets from 7:00 p.m.-9:00 p.m. on the first and third Thursdays of the month (during junior high youth group meetings). On first Thursdays, adoration and confessions are available; on third Thursdays, the mothers reflect on a relevant spiritual book.

### FOR MEN -

**Knights of Columbus Council 11207** – The Knights of Columbus is an international Catholic men’s fraternal organization and seeks to serve the Church in various ways. We have a very active council at St. Patrick’s, hosting events such as the annual book sale, fish fries, pancake breakfasts, spaghetti dinners, and assisting with events like Trivia Night and the All Saints Party. The Knights meet every month on the first Tuesday of the month, praying the Rosary at 6:30 p.m. in the church, followed by the business meeting in Kolbe

Classroom at 7:00 p.m. All practicing Catholic men over age 18 are welcome to join the Knights; our Council welcomes new members. Stop by a monthly meeting to find out more.

**That Man Is You! (T.M.I.Y.)** – This group meets on Saturday mornings for reflection and discussion to help men grow in their faith, following a nationally-acclaimed men’s ministry program. Men are encouraged to arrive early for the 7:00 a.m. Mass and then proceed to Aquinas Hall for the weekly meeting. On the last Saturday of the month, the men meet for fellowship and breakfast at Plank’s on Parsons.

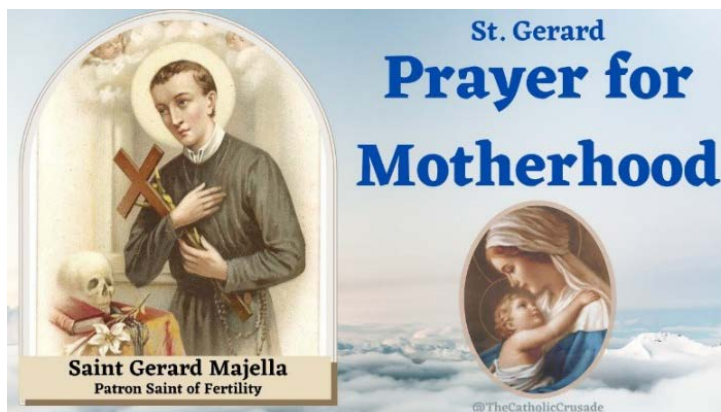


### THE APPEAL 2024
