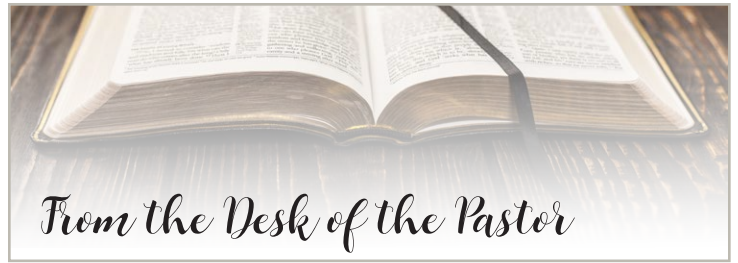

From the Desk of the Pastor

In the last few months at our parish, we have been blessed with the formation of a new group, the Rosary Confraternity. In one sense, this is not new to our parish, but in another sense, its establishment is providential. Since 2002, the Province of St. Joseph's headquarters for the Confraternity of the Holy Rosary has been at St. Patrick's, and a friar here has served as the Promoter of the Rosary. Back in the fall, after our Province's successful Dominican Rosary Pilgrimage in Washington, D.C., I approached Fr. Stephen about the possibility of getting a more stabilized group for the Confraternity on the parish level, since everything done for the Confraternity here was really for the whole Province. I remember telling Fr. Stephen: "If the Province ever moved the headquarters out of Columbus, we would have nothing for the Confraternity at St. Pat's." He gave me the green light to move forward.

That's where Divine Providence came in! When I received the call in January that I would be succeeding Fr. Stephen as the new pastor of St. Patrick's, I was also informed that the Province would be moving the headquarters for the Rosary Confraternity back to New York, where it had been before 2002. This will now allow a friar working with the Dominican Foundation to be fully dedicated to this important ministry, rather than it being a part-time ministry for a friar at St. Patrick's. This news prompted me to get a parish chapter of the Confraternity up and running before the headquarters moved.

And what fervor we have seen – a dedicated group of parishioners who meet monthly for a discussion or talk on the Rosary, and who seek ways to promote the Rosary in our parish and in our families. The group then concludes their meeting with praying the Rosary. New members are always welcome to join the meetings, held in the Kolbe classroom from 7:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m. on the third Thursday of each month.

From this enthusiastic start, we have also seen the Holy Spirit moving, looking at ways in which we could deepen our devotion to the Rosary. Our parish already prays the Rosary after the 7:00 a.m. and 11:45 a.m. Masses on weekdays. With the suggestion and assistance of the parish Rosary Confraternity, I have decided to add additional times to our parish devotional schedule, so that parishioners can pray the Rosary before certain weekend Masses. Beginning next weekend, the Rosary Confraternity will begin leading the Rosary at 4:30 p.m. on Saturday afternoons, and at 8:30 a.m. on Sunday mornings, before the respective 5:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. Masses. But there will be something special to this! The Confraternity members will be leading the Rosary according to the Dominican method of praying the Rosary. This method is a little different from what you may be used to, as it opens in a way

that resembles the Liturgy of the Hours (prayer pamphlets will be available to help follow this method). Two Confraternity members will lead the Rosary for all who wish to pray, and will do so in a way that will finish the devotion in about 15 minutes, leaving ample time for silent prayer before Mass begins. I encourage you to come early for the praying of the Rosary, especially families, and to learn a special part of our own Dominican tradition. The praying of the Rosary is ultimately a form of meditation, and praying it before certain weekend Masses will help us prepare our hearts as we enter into the Eucharistic mystery, while keeping a prayerful atmosphere in the church before Mass.

If you're interested in joining the Rosary Confraternity, we will have solemn enrollments after Masses on August 15th, the Assumption of Our Lady. And if you can't come to the monthly meetings, you can still be a member of the Confraternity; membership is dependent upon praying 15 decades of the Rosary each week.

UPDATED PROCEDURES AND POLICIES FOR REQUESTING MASS INTENTIONS

Everyone is welcome to have Masses offered by the Dominican friars at St. Patrick's. Masses may be offered for both the living and the deceased. Please note a few updates to the procedures and policies for requesting Mass intentions:

- Masses may be offered publicly in the parish church (an "announced" intention), or privately in the priory chapel (an "unannounced" intention). The donation for announced or unannounced intentions is \$10.00, which is a stipend received by the friars once the Mass is offered.
- One may schedule no more than six announced Mass intentions per year in the church. However, one may schedule an unlimited number of unannounced Mass intentions to be offered in the priory chapel.
- Requests for Mass intentions may only be done in-person at the Parish Office during regular business hours, or may be sent to the Parish Office through U.S. Mail (with a check included). Mass intentions cannot be received over the phone or through email.
- The donation for Mass intentions must be paid when requesting a Mass. Masses will not be scheduled without a payment (we cannot accept "I.O.U.s" for Mass intentions). Payment can only be made through cash or personal check; we will no longer accept credit cards or *WeShare* online giving for Mass intentions.
- Special intentions or anonymous Mass intentions cannot be offered in the parish church as announced intentions. These will only be scheduled in the priory chapel as unannounced intentions.

The friars regret any inconveniences these new procedures and policies may cause, especially if anyone has been used to making donations electronically or scheduling over the phone. The friars have recently restructured their own bank accounts, and the stipends for Mass intentions are received by the Dominican friars, not St. Patrick Parish. The regulation of donations for Mass intentions is governed strictly by canon law, and differs from other types of giving to the church. These new procedures and policies will ensure that all transactions for Mass intentions are done efficiently, and in line with Church law. Thank you for your understanding!

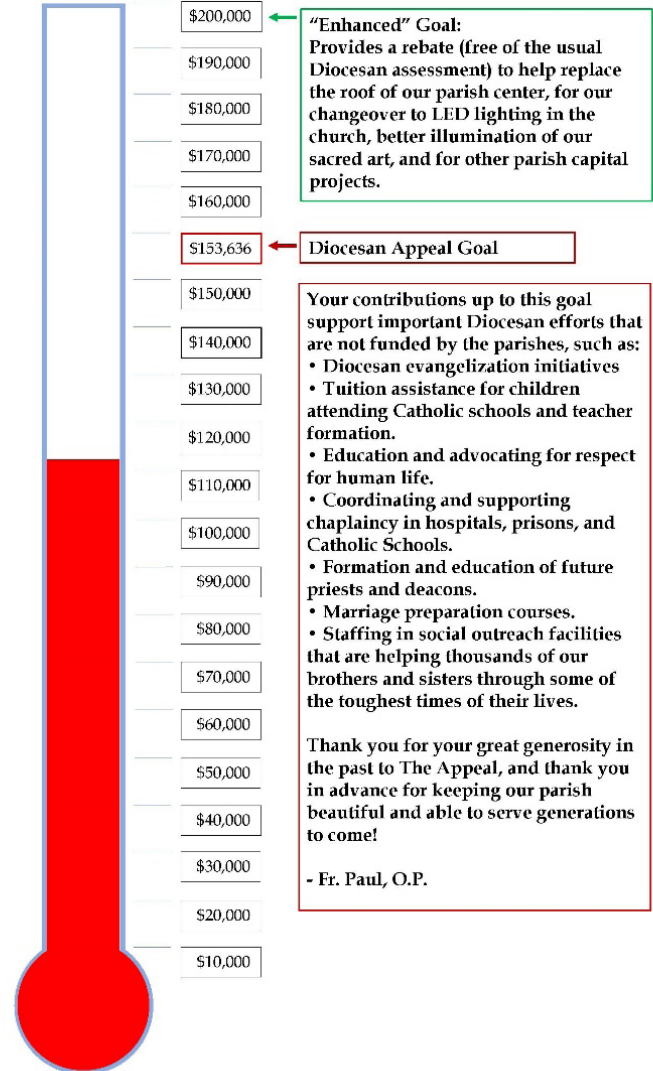
