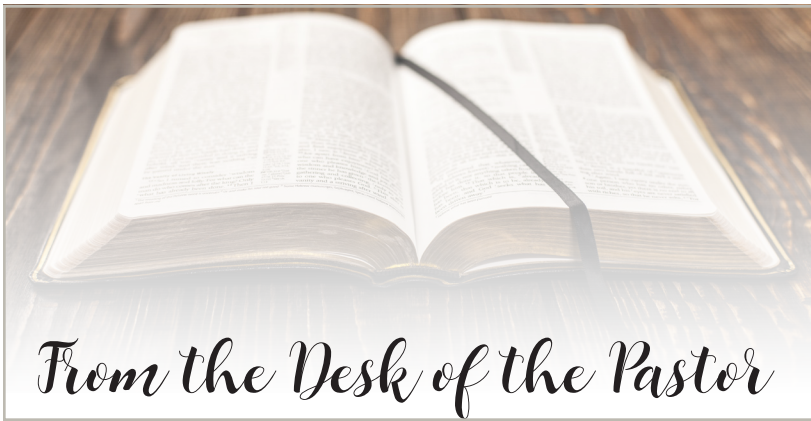

From the Desk of the Pastor

Last week, I received some wonderful news about an upcoming blessing for our parish community, something that will be a once-in-a-lifetime event for the parish. In honor of the Triple Jubilee of St. Thomas Aquinas (commemorating the 700th anniversary of his canonization in 2023, the 750th anniversary of his death in 2024, and the 800th anniversary of his birth in 2025), the Dominican Province of Toulouse, France (where St. Thomas' relics are kept) will be loaning his relics to the Dominican Province of St. Joseph for a tour of our various parishes later this year. I am thrilled to announce that St. Patrick's will host the relics of St. Thomas Aquinas on December 7th and 8th! Bishop Fernandes will join us for the 9:00 a.m. Mass that weekend as we welcome the relics of the Angelic Doctor. The centerpiece of the relics is the skull of St. Thomas, which is kept safe in a large reliquary that will be displayed for public veneration.

The relics of St. Thomas Aquinas have not been on such a tour in the United States, so this is truly a unique opportunity. Saint Thomas is important to the Dominican Order, and to the entire Church, for the contributions that he made to the study of philosophy and theology. He was brilliant, but more importantly, he was holy, and he continues to intercede for us in heaven. His witness shows us how faith and reason are not opposed to each other, but work in union, helping us come to our knowledge of the One, True God. He is the patron saint of students and of Catholic universities. Our parish has promoted the Angelic Warfare Confraternity over the last several years, a Confraternity of the Dominican Order which promotes living the virtue of chastity, with St. Thomas Aquinas as a patron.

Saint Thomas Aquinas also has an important place for the Dominicans in Columbus. From 1905-1965, the Dominican friars ran Aquinas High School, and many of their alumni continue to attend our parish. The presence of Aquinas Hall at our parish is a way to honor the legacy of Aquinas High School (with some memorabilia from the school kept in Aquinas Hall). I know that his event will be very special for the many alumni of Aquinas High School still living in the Columbus area.

Needless to say, this event will be big; we are anticipating many visitors from Columbus and beyond who will come to St. Patrick's for the public veneration of the relics (which will take place outside of our weekend Masses). We will be needing help from several parish organizations to help with some of the logistical planning and ushering of the many visitors who will be coming to our parish for this momentous event in our parish history. During this time of the Triple Jubilee of

St. Thomas, there is also an opportunity to receive a plenary indulgence when making a pilgrimage to a Dominican church. The veneration of these relics will truly be a fitting time to obtain this indulgence.

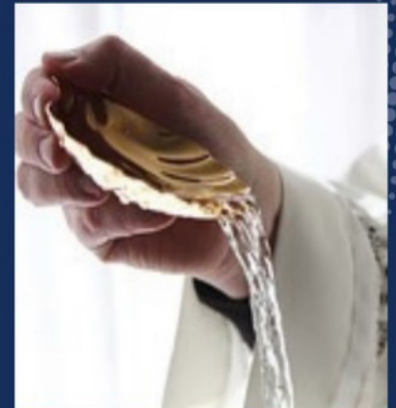

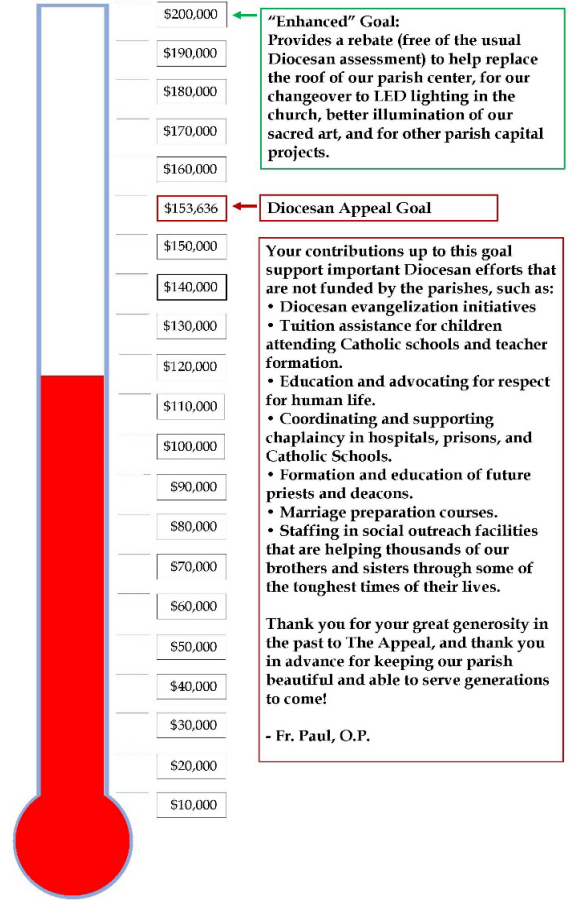
