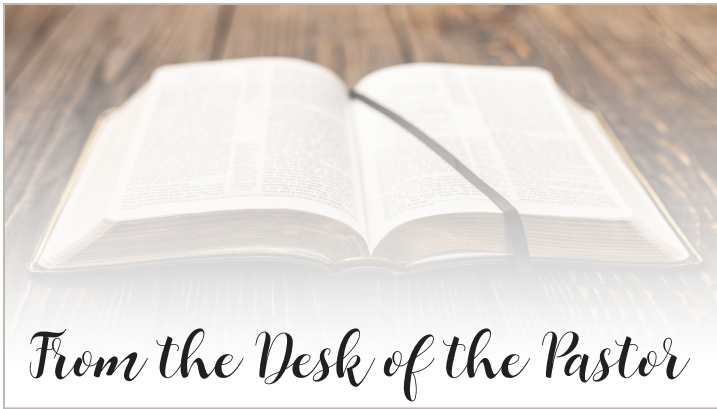

As you've come to church over the last couple of weeks, you've probably noticed some improvements and repairs going on in the Gallery:

- **The St. Dominic Shrine:** major progress has continued on the new shrine in honor of St. Dominic, with a newly commissioned pedestal for our statue of the founder of the Dominican Order. The pedestal was designed by architect and parishioner Daniel DeGreve, and built by craftsman Tim Sprosty. The new pedestal incorporates the Dominican shield, while also having a close stain match to the stain of the wainscoting throughout the Gallery. With the pedestal in place, we will now look forward to adding votive candles and a new kneeler, and hope to have a formal dedication in 2025.
- **Baptismal Font:** the baptismal font has been out of use for the last couple of weeks for stone sealing and masonry repair. A little over a year ago, after a baptism had ended, I noticed some chipped stone near the area where the square base and the bowl of the font meet. Additionally, I noticed flaking on the sidewall of the bowl. After investigating what the problem was, it was determined that moisture had been seeping into the stonework for years, weakening the stone. After drying out the bowl of the font for nearly a week, it was sealed, which will prevent any further leakage into the stone work. With this stage complete, the next step will be repairing the chipped stone near the base.
- **Gallery Confessional:** one change you may not be aware of yet is the restoration of the Gallery Confessional, which was located in the small room across from the new St. Dominic Shrine when the Gallery was built in 2002. Some years later, due to needed re-adjustment of space in the Parish Office, the room had to be re-purposed as the Parish Records Room. However, we have been able to adjust and find new storage space in other parts of the building, allowing us to re-open this room once again for its original purpose. Once this project is completed, the Gallery Confessional will serve as a third confessional on First Fridays and when we have an influx of penitents (especially during Advent and Lent), and can also be used if someone requests a quick confession from a priest, or for those with limited mobility.

All of these improvements will help us keep the Gallery a sacred space, as a place for prayer and preparation before we enter the Church, where Christ awaits us in the Blessed Sacrament!

As we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King today, may Jesus always reign as the king of all our hearts. And as we gather with our family and friends for Thanksgiving this week, may we always remember the good things that God has given to us, and give Him thanks for all the blessings He has bestowed! DECEMBER 9th – A HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION

This year, the liturgical calendar has the rare occurrence of the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception (December 8th) falling on the Second Sunday of Advent. Because the Second Sunday of Advent takes precedence on the liturgical calendar, the solemnity is transferred to the following day, Monday, December 9th. When this has happened in the past (as it last did in 2019), the transferred feast was not a holy day, and there was no obligation to attend Mass. However, a canonical question was presented to the Vatican by the U.S. bishops, and our country received a different answer – this solemnity must remain a Holy Day of Obligation (even if it is transferred). This is because the Immaculate Conception is the patronal feast day of the United States, and no permission was ever given to suppress the obligation if the holy day fell on a Monday.

With this being said, Monday, December 9th, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, **IS** a Holy Day of Obligation this year. Our parish Masses will be at 7:00 a.m., 10:00 a.m., 12:00 Noon, and 6:30 p.m., and there will be no confessions that day. Because the feast falls on a Monday, we are unable to have a Vigil Mass on Sunday evening, since that would still be the Second Sunday of Advent, so we will have one less Mass than usual for a Holy Day schedule. Please ignore any liturgical calendars or publications which say it is not a Holy Day, since those were printed well before the new directive from Rome.


