Dear Parishioners,

This is an exciting week at St. Patrick's – Vacation Bible School (VBS). This is always a special week for me, as I came to St. Patrick's during the summer of 2011 as a student brother to work VBS. That was a chance for me to get to know many of the families of our parish, many of whom I stayed in touch with after that summer and was a sign of things to come for my future ministry here. I also ended up using a ladder incorrectly that summer to hang a banner, leaving two marks near the ceiling of Patrick Hall (which were never painted over until last year!). I guess you could say I left my mark that summer! It is exciting that we have Br. Raphael and Br. Patrick with us this summer to work VBS, continuing the long-standing tradition of Dominican student brothers helping with this ministry for their summer assignment.

This year's theme for VBS is *Cathletics*, a sports-related theme, which is quite fitting for 2024 as we anticipate next month's Summer Olympics in Paris. It also harkens back to what St. Paul reminds us in his first letter to the Corinthians: "every athlete exercises discipline in every way. They do it to win a perishable crown, but we can imperishable one" (1 Cor 9:25). Studying faith takes a lot of hard work and discipline, and this is true at any age, not just for young people. But we don't do it for merely gaining knowledge, or for any human glory. We do it because we know it has an end in sight – eternal life with God in heaven. Our parish is blessed with a strong C.C.D. program for our children, which is supported by our youth ministry program. In the coming months, I hope to increase our adult catechesis program at St. Patrick's, because all of us need to keep studying our faith, regardless of our age. Like an athlete trying to improve on the playing field, all of us can grow in our knowledge of the truth, as we seek to deepen our relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ.

Please pray for the children of our parish this week, that the graces of VBS may help them become stronger disciples of Jesus Christ.

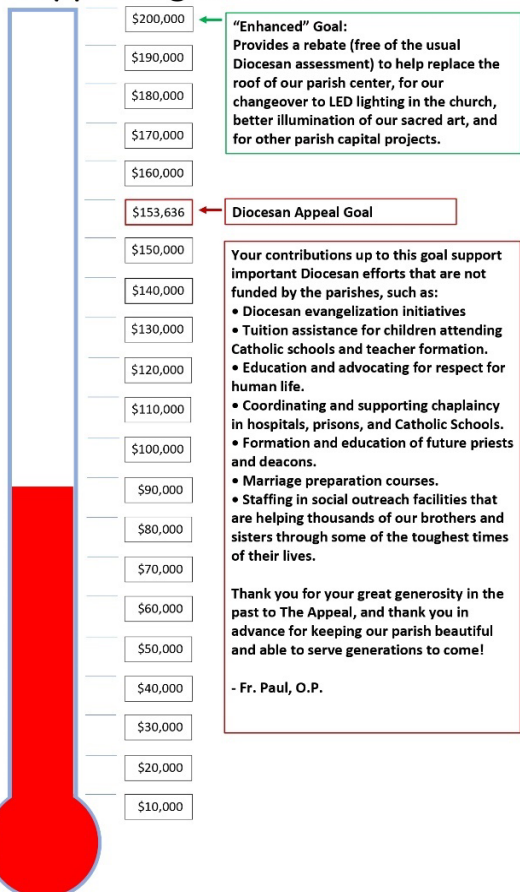

Some background:

Inspired by Saint Margaret of Castello, O.P. the ministry known as **Little Margaret's Charity** has served as St. Patrick's charitable arm for over fifteen years.

Fifth Sunday Collections: Four times a year, during the months which include a fifth Sunday, the 2nd Collection at all Masses benefits Little Margaret's Charity.

Poor Box: Funds dropped in the poor boxes in the church also support the various causes of Little Margaret's Charity.


Donations to Little Margaret's Charity through the 5th Sunday Collection and the Poor Box support parishioners in need, as well as a number of pro-life organizations, including Ohio Right to Life, Greater Columbus Right to Life, Women's Care Center, PDHC, and Bethesda Healing Ministry. The poor and homeless of downtown are also aided by contributions to the Holy Family Soup Kitchen, Faith Mission, J.O.I.N., and the Community Kitchen.

Little Margaret's Charity also sponsors the annual **Giving Tree** at Christmas. The 2023 Giving Tree campaign enabled us to help 15 families, a total of 68 individuals, enjoy a little brighter Christmas. Parishioners donated over \$4,000 in gift cards, and nearly \$5,000 in cash, to assist these parish families.
