Dear Parishioners,

What a great honor it is to have Bishop Fernandes here this weekend to install me as the new pastor of St. Patrick's. Timing couldn't have been better – when planning the installation Mass, the Bishop's schedule for the summer was filling up quickly. Our options were June 29 or waiting until September or even October. We went with June 29, which also happens to be the Solemnity of SS. Peter and Paul. Obviously, this is a very important day for me as my patronal feast day, but more importantly, it is a significant day in the Church's calendar in which we remember the two great apostles of Rome. Saints Peter and Paul preached the Gospel at the very beginning of the Church, traveling far and facing many trials to fulfill their mission, a mission entrusted to them by Jesus. Their zeal for the Gospel is further inspiration for me as I begin my new role as pastor. And we're receiving a special treat: Though this weekend's Saturday Vigil Mass would normally use the readings and prayers for the 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Bishop is giving us special permission to celebrate the Mass for the feast, with the readings and prayers for the solemnity (for those who attend the installation Mass on Saturday evening, it still fulfills your Sunday obligation, even though you won't be hearing the Sunday readings).

The installation of the pastor of a parish is not a sacrament like holy orders but is a rite that the Church gives us as a way of showing the order and communion within the one, holy, Catholic, and apostolic Church. The Bishop presides as the chief shepherd of the diocese, a reminder to us that he is the chief shepherd of the local church. He is responsible for the pastoral care of the flock within his diocese, but this is such a heavy task; he needs co-workers to help him. This happens through the ministry of priests at a parish, which Canon Law defines as "a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor" (*Code of Canon Law* 515, section 1).

Within the installation Mass, the new pastor (instead of the deacon) proclaims the Gospel, signifying the responsibility he will have of proclaiming the Gospel to his flock. After the homily, the new pastor renews his promises of obedience before the Bishop, reminding us that his ministry is done in communion with him. The new pastor then leads the congregation in the Nicene Creed, as he will be entrusted with leading his flock to profess the one, true faith. The new pastor then continues with his own Oath of Fidelity, assuring his flock that he will teach them the truth, not by a simple promise, but under oath before Almighty God. The Bishop then leads the new pastor to his own chair in the sanctuary, signifying that the Bishop has entrusted this priest with the pastoral care of this parish. It is a rite filled with great symbolism and much beauty, and is really a celebration for the entire parish community.

As I am installed this weekend as your new pastor, I rely on your prayers in the years ahead. Please pray that I may be

a faithful pastor, guided by the Holy Spirit, inspired by SS. Peter and Paul, as well as St. Patrick and St. Dominic, all of whom were pastors after the heart of Christ!



Some background:

Inspired by Saint Margaret of Castello, O.P., the ministry known as Little Margaret's Charity has served as St. Patrick's charitable arm for over fifteen years.

Fifth Sunday Collections: Four times a year, during the months which include a fifth Sunday, the 2nd Collection at all Masses benefits Little Margaret's Charity.

Poor Box: Funds dropped in the poor boxes in the church also support the various causes of Little Margaret's Charity.

Donations to Little Margaret's Charity through the 5th Sunday Collection and the Poor Box support parishioners in need, as well as several pro-life organizations, including Ohio Right to Life, Greater Columbus Right to Life, Women's Care Center, PDHC, and Bethesda Healing Ministry. The poor and homeless of downtown are also aided by contributions to the Holy Family Soup Kitchen, Faith Mission, J.O.I.N., and the Community Kitchen.

Little Margaret's Charity also sponsors the annual Giving Tree at Christmas. The 2023 Giving Tree campaign enabled us to help 15 families, a total of 68 individuals, enjoy a little brighter Christmas. Parishioners donated over \$4,000 in gift cards, and nearly \$5,000 in cash, to assist these parish families.

EdChoice: Empowering Parents Today for the Future

The Ohio Educational Choice (EdChoice) Scholarship Program provides students throughout the State of Ohio the opportunity to attend participating private schools for **little or no cost**. Enacted in 2005 to serve families living in underperforming school districts, the program has since expanded to provide **increased opportunities** to **ALL** Ohio families with scholarships up to \$6,166 for K-8 and \$8,408 for grades 9-12.

MAX SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNTS K-8: \$6,166/student 9-12: \$8,408/student



Due to the recent changes in the state's biennial budget, families 450% or below of the Federal Poverty Guideline are eligible for the full EdChoice scholarship amount. Families above 450% will be eligible for a portion of the scholarship, dependent on their income and family size.


What are Federal Poverty Guidelines?

The poverty guidelines are a simplified version of the statistical thresholds used by U.S. Census Bureau for calculating the number of people in poverty. Poverty guidelines are issued each

year in the Federal Register by the



U.S. Department of Health & Human Services to determine financial eligibility for certain programs and vary by family size. In 2023, a family of four (4) at 450% of the Federal Poverty Guideline has a gross income of \$135,000/year.



The Catechism of the Catholic Church clearly states, "Parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children," and, "As those first responsible for the education of their children, <u>parents</u> <u>have the right to choose</u>

<u>a school for them which corresponds to</u> <u>their own convictions</u>. The right is fundamental."


