This month of July is dedicated to the Precious Blood of Jesus, as the Feast of the Most Precious Blood was traditionally celebrated on July 1st. Meditating on the Precious Blood of Jesus gives us an opportunity to reflect on the mystery of Christ's Passion, and the salvation He won for us by offering His blood in sacrifice.

Blood is a sign of life, and in the Old Testament, the blood of lambs and bulls would be offered in sacrifice and used as a sign of salvation. We can think of the lamb's blood being spread on the doorposts of the Israelites while still in Egypt, and how Moses sprinkled the people of Israel with blood when they received the Covenant. But the blood of animals was a sign; how could this save us from the scourge of sin?

In Jesus Christ, we behold the true Lamb of God, who comes to take away the sins of the world. He is one like us in all things but sin, and by His saving sacrifice, we have been saved from our sin. Christ was unjustly put to death, but His death became our life. The blood He poured out on the Cross for us is truly saving. His blood is life-giving, for in Christ's Blood, our sins are washed away, and the promise of eternal life in heaven is opened up for us.

In the Eucharist, we receive the body and blood of Christ (even when we receive Our Lord only under the appearance of bread, we are receiving the whole Christ, including His blood). When we receive the Eucharist, we become one with Christ, and we experience in our lives the power of His blood to wash away sin and purify our souls. Though Christ suffered on the Cross, His Blood now becomes a sign of His victory, and a source of life for us.

As this month of July unfolds, may we reflect more deeply on Christ's Passion, and the power of His blood to purify us and give us new life. Should we ever be discouraged because of some sin, especially from the past, may we always remember that the Most Precious Blood of Christ washes away all our sins, for it is the blood of our God who became man.

WEEKDAY PARISH DEVOTIONAL UPDATES

As of Monday, July 1st, we have begun praying the Prayer to St. Michael the Archangel after all weekday Masses. After the priest gives the final blessing, he goes to reverence the altar, and begins the prayer before genuflecting and leaving the sanctuary. Additionally, the praying of the Angelus/Regina Caeli before Mass, already practiced before the 7:00 a.m. Mass, has been extended to the 11:45 a.m. Mass. Cards with these prayers are available in the pews, so that the faithful can use a consistent version of these prayers in common. The Novena to St. Margaret of Castello will continue to be prayed after each Mass on Wednesdays and will follow the prayer to St. Michael. The faithful are also reminded that the Rosary is prayed in common each day after the 7:00 a.m. and 11:45 a.m. Masses. On Fridays the Eucharistic Holy Hour is held from 12:15 p.m.-1:15 p.m.
