Imentioned briefly during the announcements last weekend that the *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults* (R.C.I.A.) has been renamed — it is now called the *Order of Christian Initiation of Adults* (O.C.I.A.). Some may wonder: why the change? Well, just as the translation of the *Roman Missal* was revised 13 years ago (when we had to re-learn our responses at Mass), bishops from the English-speaking world have continued to revise the other liturgical books. We experienced this a little over a year ago when the words of absolution in the Sacrament of Penance changed slightly, as the *Rite of Penance* became the *Order of Penance*. Next on the docket were the prayers and rituals for the initiation of adults, and the celebrations of Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion at the Easter Vigil.

This change of name may be a little confusing for us at first (especially for our many parishioners who went through R.C.I.A.), but like the new translation of the Mass, I'm sure we'll get used to it over time. One reason for the change of name from *Rite* to *Order* is to emphasize the whole process of the Christian initiation of adults. Whereas the word "rite" implies rituals or ceremonies, "order" envisions a whole, ordered process, which includes rites and ceremonies, as well as preparation, catechesis, support, and further instruction after Baptism and reception into the Church (which is called *mystagogy*).

Regardless of the name, O.C.I.A. continues to serve the same purpose that it served when it was called R.C.I.A. — to help form adults in the faith, from those who seek to be baptized, as well as those adults who were baptized in other denominations, and who wish to enter the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil. Our parish has a rich tradition of a strong R.C.I.A. program led by a Dominican friar, and Fr. Albert will continue to lead this ministry under the name O.C.I.A. He will have more to say in the weeks ahead about some of the particular changes within the revised translation of this liturgical book.

In the meantime, I have a challenge for everyone in our parish — do you know someone who is interested in becoming Catholic, or has been inquiring about the Catholic faith? Consider inviting them to look at our O.C.I.A. program. The joy of your own witness to the Catholic faith will be the best inspiration for them!

IMPORTANT UPDATES TO MARRIAGE PREPARATION TIME

Over the last few months, the Diocese of Columbus has been implementing new marriage preparation guidelines, which are in line with instructions from the Vatican regarding the time of marriage preparation. In the past, the minimum time for marriage preparation was six months. However, marriage preparation will now be using a catechetical model, similar to the one used for the Baptism of adults, which will increase the time of marriage preparation to 9-12 months. Effective September 1, 2024, all couples interested in getting married at St. Patrick's must submit a Marriage Request Form at least 9 months before their intended wedding date. Additionally, if either the bride or groom would be under the age of 19 on the date of their wedding, a longer waiting time must occur between the conclusion of marriage preparation and the wedding date, and a parent consultation meeting must occur. Any exceptions for a shorter time of marriage preparation must be made in writing to the pastor.




